

Round Rock ISD 1st Grade High-Frequency Word List

According to the ELAR TEKS, each First Grade student should read, identify, & write at least 100 high-frequency words by the end of the year. The RRISD word list has been revised to align to the high-frequency words suggested by the reading levels in the Fountas and Pinnell Literacy Continuum. All words on this list should be used during instruction; however, students should read, identify and write at least 100 words from the list. *Note: Showing mastery of writing high-frequency words should come from evidence in student reading and writing - not a spelling test in the form of an isolated list.*
